

Now, if I don't know about a crisis in your life, and you or one of your friends does not reach out to me or the church office to let me know—honestly, I'm not a very good guesser. I have enough trouble guessing what Sister Jennie wants much of the time. How much more so for anyone I haven't known for over 20 years? Alas my "direct line to the divine" does not keep me informed that way!

When it does seem like I miraculously know about something difficult you or a loved one is going through, it's probably because you told someone who thought I should know. That's not a miracle—that's the power of friendship!

My family members all understand that they always come first—except in a pastoral emergency or crisis. Please don't hesitate to reach out when you need me—or Sister Jennie if you prefer—or even if you think you might. I'd rather help you decide over the phone whether you need me than miss an opportunity to be there for you or your family.

Sister Jennie and I both have our numbers in Calvary's phone directory, and the office has

standing instructions to give it out freely to those who've misplaced or not yet received one. Also, phone messages left at Calvary now produce transcripts that come to my email when the office is not open. And although I take most Fridays off (except Lunch with Friends), I'm still "on call"—and part of the joy of our partnership is that sometimes Sister Jennie can jump in when I do need a break or am otherwise unavailable.

In short, when in doubt about whether you should call or text me or call the church office, or have a friend or family member do so when you cannot, please err on the side of reaching out. Whenever you call, I'll be there, as soon as humanly possible, by the gracious support of the One who called me to this work!

Let's celebrate that and wait in anticipation as the space takes shape and comes together along with them.

Dear Calvary Friends,

The Easter Season is upon us! A great time to reflect during Lent and celebrate on Easter.

"Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long." (Psalm 25:5)

Be sure to join us on Wednesday evenings during Lent for the Holden Evening Prayer. There is a schedule posted on the bulletin board outside the Church office that details the days/times of services throughout this important season.

Our finances are doing okay. We are just a bit behind, but as you all have shown us last year, we are to have faith. Calvary was able to send money through a Special Benevolence to the Fire Victims in Los Angeles. Thank you for those that donated through this effort and donated directly to other organizations.

We are getting tight on our handicap parking spots on Sunday mornings. I encourage those of you who can walk a bit further to allow the spaces for those who have a bit more trouble. The Church property is being frequented more by our unhoused populations, and this can become a problem for us. The upper part of the property, used by our youngest Calvary members, is particularly vulnerable. We are trimming our landscape to ensure the safety of our youth and to keep the property healthy. If you drive by and see a problem, call the Grants Pass Public Safety Non-Emergency Line at (541) 450-6260. Our Public Safety Officers have asked that we not handle the issue ourselves, in case of potential violence.

On a much brighter note, we have had a lot of new visitors to our church lately. Make sure to say hello and introduce yourself.








Mid-Week "James" Bible Study
