STITCHCRAFTERS

Stitchcrafters has been an organization of women, actually an institution at Calvary for many years.



First some history. Carol Wilson tells me that some 20 years ago the group met twice a week, on Wednesdays and Thursdays. When the membership got smaller, they changed to only Wednesday. Our mission statement says we do this work in the name of the Lord. All women are considered members, even if they do not participate in the weekly "sewing" time. Thus, quilt making and sewing was the name our group came to be called.

Quilts have been made and distributed since 1987. These works of love have been given to; Asante family house, Spears Cancer Center, Gospel rescue mission, Boys correction facility, Every Child, Habitat for Humanity and disaster victims in Kentucky. Quilts have been displayed on our pews prior to our bazaars and have found many homes in our community.

This group has done many, many organized affairs; Bazaars, bake sales, rummage sales, craft sessions, swap lunches, organized outings, lefse making, etc.

The last bazaar we put on (pre-covid) took in over \$15,000. This accomplishment could only be done with the support of our congregation.

The monies raised through these endeavors has been shared with many charities; Lutheran world relief, the YMCA, Every Child, Women's Crisis Support Team, The Roc, Casa, Food and Friends, Rogue Valley Humane Society, and of course our church. At church, we have spearheaded the remodel of the kitchen, a new refrigerator, additional outlets, the drinking fountain, maintenance items (doors and paint), bulletin boards, and more. We have presented our high school grads with a monetary gift, and made baptism quilts for our newest members as they come to be blessed.

We have a small group of gals that come to work on quilts on Wednesday mornings. There are planned activities for the coming months, Bake sale, Lefse making, quilt/bake sale, greens craft and sale. I encourage any of you that are interested to come and join us.

Join us are the operative words here! There will be a meeting on **Wednesday**, **August 9**th **at 9:30** in the fellowship hall.

We will be discussing our planned events and more importantly, our future. Do we need to change our name? What other activities are of interest? How can we involve more of the younger women in the congregation? As our church has changed in the last few years, is it time for us to change as well? All input is welcome!
