

Calvary's Endowment Fund: Investing in the Future

During the past year, our congregation learned of the need for church leaders who are equipped for mission and ministry.

Calvary's Endowment Fund Committee felt called to address this issue and recently gifted \$2,000 to the ELCA Fund for Leaders, an endowed scholarship program that was created 25 years ago to support students attending seminary.

The average annual tuition at an ELCA seminary is now \$16,000 and that does not include living expenses ranging from \$20,000 to \$30,000. That brings the cumulative cost of attending seminary (three academic years) to a range of \$80,000-\$117,000. Students make tremendous sacrifices to answer God's call and over 80% must take out loans. Many pastors who feel called to serve smaller or struggling congregations simply cannot accept such calls because the salary would not allow them to meet their loan commitments.

This past year 375 seminary students received nearly \$3.5 million in scholarships from the ELCA fund. We are pleased that Calvary will now have a part in the ultimate goal of helping every seminary candidate graduate without the burden of financial debt.

What Does It Mean To Be Present?

This is the first draft of the story I told in May 5th's sermon.

The family at the other table were believers. They demonstrated two things for me: Joy in sadness at the release of a loved one to God's arms, at the end of a horrible disease. The importance of being in the present moment so that we do not miss out on a God moment. Three couples who have known each other since Seminary days (40+ years), met in Waldport for a reunion. My wife Judy and I were one of the couples.

A good time was had by all. Lots of catching up. Lots of 'remember when...'. Fun times finding good seafood dinners.

The last night was a fun dinner in Yachats.

I was trying to hold my iPhone just right to get all 6 of us in a picture - attached if I can manage it. A young woman in another large party came over and offered to take the picture for us. We thanked her and I reciprocated by going over to their party of 8 or 9 and taking their picture. Dad, head of the family, turned out to be a joker like me. He gave me a hearty handshake and we exchanged pleasantries; me about who we were and what we were doing. Dad joked about being careful of the daughter who took our picture, as she fell in the ocean with her phone. (Not true.) Like I said, dad and I were a couple of jokers.)

When we got done eating and five of the six of us were out the door, I went back to see my new buddy. We shook hands again and said we would call each other next time we were in town. (No phone numbers were exchanged.)

I asked, "What brings the family to Waldport?" The conversation took a hard right.

"Our mom went to heaven last night," the one daughter said.

I looked at my new friend. "She died?"

He nodded.

"Last night?" I was stunned. Eight or nine of them in this restaurant, eating, laughing and joking.

"Yup," he said. "She died at 3:16 this morning.

What would YOU say?

I looked at this gathered family. They maintained their smiles - not pasted on, genuine. A family celebrating the life of their wife and mother, released from some dread disease. I looked at each of them. "I'm so sorry." I said.

"I'm all cried out," our photographer said. "Don't get me started again."

I shook dad's hand again, holding onto his hand. He had a great grasp.

I looked slowly around the table.

"We're taking her down to Brookings and were putting her ashes in a waterfall. She wanted to end up in the ocean."

I looked at dad - her husband - and his family, gathered together.

"Peace to her memory," I said, "and the comfort of the Holy Spirt be with all of you." Dad's expression softened. "Thank you," he said, as did some of the family.

We spent a moment more, silent, and I turned and joined Judy, who had come back into the restaurant, wondering where the heck I had gone, and we left.

I left, stunned at the story this family invited me to be a part of. Shared in the joyous remembrance of their wife and mother.

Honored to bless her in Christ's name.
