I invite you to join me on a 40-day journey in Lent starting February 22 with our Ash Wednesday service of ashes. Our foreheads are marked with ashes to remind us of our mortality. It reminds us that this life will end. Nonetheless, in that ending we live in the hope of life with God.

Our Lenten journey will then continue with an invitation to live simply and keep our focus on repentance and returning to God's grace. There will be 6 Sundays between Ash Wednesday and Easter Sunday. The colors on the altar during this season will be purple. This deep, rich color has come to represent somberness and solemnity, penitence, and prayer. On the 5 Sundays before Passion (Palm) Sunday the adult class will be focusing on a video series called "How Lutherans Interpret the Bible". Pastor John and I will be facilitators.

Mid-week Lenten services will be held at 6:30 on Wednesday. We will use the "Joyous Light" as our worship setting. Each service will feature one of our members giving a brief address on "My favorite Bible verse." Prior to the service a simple soup and bread supper will be held in the Fellowship Hall beginning at 5:30 PM.

"Taking Faith Home", which is available on-line and as handouts in the narthex, is a great resource for your daily Bible readings during this season.

May your Lent be full of simplicity and renewal this year!
